

Dayalbagh Educational Institute

The Government of India conferred the status of Deemed University on Dayalbagh Educational Institute (DEI), Dayalbagh, Agra under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act on 16th May, 1981. The Institute is located in Dayalbagh, a self-contained colony renowned for its serene environment and secular establishments, in which its inhabitants lead an active, disciplined and cooperative community life, conforming to the high spiritual ideals of their faith.

Education System & Mission Objectives

Since its inception in 1981, The University has successfully implemented an innovative, comprehensive and value based education system with the mission objective of evolving a complete man (a well-rounded total quality person). The education system fosters academic excellence along with holistic development and aims to bring about physical, intellectual, emotional and ethical integration of the individual.

In pursuance of its mission objective of evolving a 'complete man', DEI's curriculum includes core courses and co-curricular activities which encourage the well-rounded development of the individual. These include the following: Cultural Education; Comparative Study of Religion; Scientific Methodology, General Knowledge Current Affairs; Rural Development; Agricultural Operations; Social Service; and CoCurricular Activities (cultural and literary activities, games sports). It also includes work based programmes that takes the form of practical training in areas related to subjects. the major distinguishing feature of DEI's education policy is its emphasis on combining excellence relevance to contemporary needs. Recently, a high power committee set up by the Ministry of Human Resource Development ranked DEI 8th amongst 126 deemed universities in India.



Programmes

The Dayalbagh Educational Institute comprises six faculties (Arts, Commerce, Education, Engineering, Science and Social Sciences), twenty two departments, and three non-university colleges -DEI Technical College, DEI Prem Vidvalava Girls Intermediate College and REI Intermediate College. DEI also manages, both academically and administratively, schools in Madhya Pradesh, New Delhi and Roorkee. This has enabled the creation of an integrated education system from K-12 through UG, PG and PhD.

The University offers around 75 programmes at Certificate, Diploma, UG Degree, PG Diploma, PG Degree and Research Degree levels. The faculty strength is 243 while the student strength is 4223 at the University level.

The DEI model of education



provides multiple entry and exit points enabling a student to move from the vocational to the academic stream and vice-versa, on clearing requisite tests. It integrates seamlessly with the AICTE National Vocational Education Qualification Framework (NVEQF). Recognizing this, AICTE has selected DEI as the

first Institute under the NVEQE DEI Technical College, DEI Prem Vidyalaya Girls Intermediate College and REI Intermediate College are registered as Vocational Educational Providers and DEI Centre for Applied Rural Technology is registered as Skill Knowledge Provider.



The important administrative bodies governing the Institute are as follows:

Primary Body

The Primary Body of the Institute consists of 25 members which includes the President (Chairman), Director, Treasurer, Deans of Faculties, six members nominated by the General Body of the Institute, a nominee of the Ministry of Education, Government of India; Secretary Education, U.P.; a nominee of the All India Council for Technical Education, one nominee from each of the three educational societies, *viz.* the D.E.I. Women's Training College Society, the D.E.I. Engineering College Society and the Managing Committee of the Radhasoami Educational Institute of Agra; a nominee of the Dayalbagh Medical Relief Society; a nominated trustee of the Dayalbagh Education Trust and two nominees of the President of the Institute. The Registrar is the ex-officio Secretary of the Primary Body (*Annexure-I*). Generally, the Primary Body meets once every year. This year, the meeting was held on 16.5.2013.

Governing Body

The Governing Body of the Institute consists of 15 members which includes the Director (Chairman), Treasurer, two Deans from amongst the Faculties of the Institute by rotation; a nominee of the Ministry of Education, Government of India; a nominee of the Chairman, UGC; Director, Higher Education, U.P.; a nominee of the Academic Council of the Institute from amongst its members; a nominee of the Radhasoami Satsang Sabha, Dayalbagh; a nominee of the Managing Committee of the Radhasoami Educational Institute of Agra; a representative each of Industry and Agriculture of Dayalbagh nominated by the President of the Institute; three eminent educationists and technologists nominated by the President of the Institute. The Registrar is the ex-officio Secretary of the Governing Body (Annexure-II). The Governing Body meets as often as necessary. This year it met five times. The last meeting was held on 11.5.2013.

Academic Council

The Academic Council of the Institute consists of the Director (Chairman), Deans of Faculties, Heads/Incharges of all the teaching departments of the University, a member of the teaching staff of each faculty not below the rank of a lecturer who is neither the Dean nor Head/Incharge, in order of seniority by

rotation; Principals of all the non-University educational institutions; the Director of Technical Education, U.P.; a nominee of the Chairman, U.G.C.; two specialists related to Industry nominated by the Governing Body and five eminent members from the fields of Arts and Culture, Commerce, Education, Engineering and Science nominated by the Governing Body. The Registrar is the ex-officio Secretary of the Academic Council (*Annexure-III*). The Academic Council meets as often as necessary. This year it met twice, the last meeting was held on 27.4.2013.

Finance Committee

The Finance Committee of the Institute consists of the Director (Chairman), Treasurer, a nominee of the Department of Finance, Government of U.P. and two nominees of the Governing Body, one of whom is a Dean and a nominee of the U.G.C. The Registrar is the ex-officio Secretary of the Finance Committee (*Annexure-IV*). The Finance Committee meets at least twice every year. The last meeting was held on 16.3.2013.

Managing Council for Non-University Technical Educational Institutions

The Managing Council for the Non-University Technical Educational Institutions consists of the Director (Chairman), Treasurer, Principals of the Non-University Technical Educational Institutions, one teacher from the Non-University Technical Educational Institution not below the rank of lecturer in order of seniority, by rotation, two nominees of the Governing Body from among its members, Director, Technical Education, U.P.; one nominee of the Northern Regional Office, A.I.C.T.E.; one nominee of the Managing Committee of the Radhasoami Educational Institute of Agra and two eminent persons not members or employees of the Institute nominated by the President. The Registrar is the ex-officio Secretary of the Council (*Annexure-V*). This year the Council met four times. The last meeting was held on 19.11.2012.

Managing Council for Non-University General Educational Institutions

The Managing Council for the Non-university General Educational Institutions consists of the Director (Chairman), Treasurer, Principals of the Non-University General Educational Institutions, one teacher from the Non-University General Educational Institutions not below the rank of teacher in order of seniority, by rotation, two nominees of the Governing Body from its members; Director, Secondary Education, U.P.; one nominee of the Ministry of Education; one nominee of the Managing Committee of the Radhasoami Educational Institute of Agra; one nominee of the DEI Prem Vidyalaya Society, Agra; one nominee of the DEI Higher Secondary School Society, Agra and two eminent persons not members or employees of the Institute nominated by the President. The Registrar is the ex-officio Secretary of the Council (*Annexure-VI*). The Council met twice this year. The last meeting was held on 19.01.2013.

Board of Studies/ Faculty Board

There is one Board of Studies for each subject offered by the Institute. The Board of Studies consists of the Head of the Department as Chairman; all Professors of the Department; one Reader and two Lecturers and an external Expert. The meetings of the Board of Studies in each Department are held one or more times each year. There is a duly constituted Faculty Board for each Faculty. It comprises all the Professors and Heads of Departments of the Faculty and two external experts, with the Dean as the Chairman. The recommendations of the Board of Studies regarding revision of syllabus and/or new courses approved by the Faculty Boards are placed before the Academic Council of the Institute before implementation. The Faculty Boards meet at least once every year.

Research Degree Committee

The Research Degree Committee closely monitors issues related to research work leading to the award of the Ph.D. degree. The members include the Director, concerned Dean, Head of the Department and two external experts in the subject. The supervisor of the candidate is the co-opted member of the Committee.

Academic and Administrative Audit Committee

The Institute has an Academic and Administrative Audit Committee that consists of ten members, which includes Deans of all the faculties, two eminent academicians and educationists and two Professors nominated by the Director (*Annexure-VII*). The Committee regularly conducts extensive survey to review the academic and administrative working and closely monitors the progress of the Institute. It has conducted an extensive exercise this year also and submitted its report to the UGC.


3.TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING STAFF (As on 31-03-2013)

5. DST PROJECT REVIEW COMMITTEE MEETING

DST Project Review Committee meeting on the consortia based project entitled "Generation, Storage and Distribution of Solar Hydrogen" with a total financial outlay of Rs 7.03 Crores, out of which DEI has been sanctioned Rs 90.45 lakh, was successfully organised at DEI, Dayalbagh from Dec. 7-8, 2012.

The expert panel which reviewed the progress of consortia based project included internationally reputed experts from Research and Development Centre - Indian oil, Faridabad; Tata Chemicals, Pune; Energy Research Development Agency (ERDA), Ahmedabad; Chemical Engineering Group, BARC, Mumbai and DST, New Delhi. The Expert Committee was headed by Prof. D. V. Singh, Ex Director, IIT- Roorkee.

In the first six monthly project review meeting, principal investigators and co-investigators hailed from Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) Mumbai; Central Electrochemical Research Institute (CECRI) Kariakudi; Indian Institute of Technology - Kanpur, Madras and Jodhpur and Dayalbagh Educational Institute (DEI), Dayalbagh, Agra. The report on the progress of work done under the project was presented and the future course of action to achieve the desired objectives was discussed.

Twentieth Conference on 'Toward a Science of Consciousness' (TSC 2013)

The Twentieth Conference on 'Toward a Science of Consciousness' (TSC 2013) was organized by the Institute from March 3 to 9, 2013 at different venues, DEI Convocation Hall, Quantum-Nano Systems Centre and Centre for Consciousness Studies. It was attended by over 400 delegates from all over the world. There were 22 plenary talks, 4 workshops, 24 concurrent sessions, 3 poster sessions and a forum on Eastern



Philosophy and Science of Consciousness besides several informal interaction and discussion sessions as well as potential collaborations and tieups. The event was inaugurated on March 5 by Prof. James Barrell, University of West Georgia, with his talk entitled "Inner Experience and Neuroscience: Merging both Perspectives". The Vision Talk was delivered by Revered Prof. P.S. Satsangi Sahab, Chairman Advisory Committee on Education, Dayalbagh Educational Institutions, entitled "Towards Integrating Arts (First-Person Spiritual-Cognitive-Material Phenomenology) and Science (Third-Person Neuro-Physical Environmental-Cognitive Correlates) of Consciousness: The Dayalbagh Vision".

Plenary Talks

There were 22 Plenary Talks given by 18 speakers from the USA, Canada, Belgium, Romania, Germany, Norway, Japan, Australia and Italy, and 4 national speakers. Various Workshops on the following aspects were conducted during the event:

- 1. Basic Neuro and Cognitive Sciences DEI Team (March 3)
- 2. Consciousness in the Universe: Review of Orchestrated OR TheoryProf. Stuart Hameroff, University of Arizona, USA (March 4)
- 3. Self in Science Prof. Menas Kafatos, Chapman University, USA (March 5)
- 4. Healing, Transformation and Higher Consciousness Dr Deepak Chopra (March 8)

Eastern Philosophy Forum featured a keynote address by Prof. James Hagelin, Maharishi University, USA. Prof. P. Sriramamurti, Dr. Vijai Kumar and Shri Prem Prashant were the DEI speakers.

TSC 2013 featured 24 concurrent sessions. Each concurrent session had 5 papers. There were around 120 posters in 3 sessions. Besides, a large number of foreign participants from different countries also witnessed presentation by the Faculty members, staff and students of the Dayalbagh Educational Institute.

Lecture-cum-Workshop on "Conservation and Use of Natural Resources for Sustainable Development"

A Two Day Lecture-cum-Workshop , under the aegis of Science Academies' Programme, was organized for the first time at the Dayalbagh Educational Institute. Key lectures were delivered by distinguished speakers focusing on the significance of non-replenishable natural mineral resources. Prof. Anand Mohan, Registrar of the Institute was the Convener of the programme.



Workshop on "Practice Research in Disaster Management: Towards Better Worldliness"

A Two Day Lecture-cum-Workshop on "Practice and Research in Disaster Management: Towards Better Worldliness" under the aegis of Science Academies' Programme, was organized by Dayalbagh Educational Institute from April 2-3, 2013. The broad sub-themes were 'Natural Disasters and Sustainable Development',

'Man-Made Disaster and Better Worldliness' and 'Disaster Management Technology and Applications'. The Registrar of the Institute, Prof. Anand Mohan, was the Convenor of the Workshop. He mentioned that the Indian sub-continent is considered as one of the most hazard-prone countries in the world where about 85% of the land area is vulnerable to various types of natural catastrophes. The available scientific data coupled with sound technology has promoted the work towards disaster mitigation and developing a viable disaster warning system. Further, there is a need to extensively promote educaton and practices related to disaster management. The Workshop was meant to achieve the following objectives:



- O To disseminate knowledge about Disaster Management practices and sensitize a broad spectrum of stakeholders including students, teachers, professionals, administrators and community towards 'Better Worldliness' ways of sustainable living.
- O To develop a road map to strengthen disaster knowledge management efforts targeting the use of such practices to enhance residence of communities.




Students' enrolment (Gender wise)

'B' and 'C' Certificate Examinations were conducted by NCC Group Head Quarter, Agra in the month of February, 2013 in which the First and the Second Year students of Technical College appeared. 32 cadets of Second Year passed the prestigious 'C' Certificate Examination whereas 83 cadets passed the 'B' Certificate Examination. Twenty cadets participated in "Rashtriya Maathdatha Divas" on 25th January 2013 in St. Jonh's College Ground, Agra.





22. GAMES AND SPORTS

Regular coaching for football/volleyball was provided to the students immediately after the start of the academic session 2012-13. Both boys and girls participated in the various games/sports events viz., football, volleyball, cricket, badminton, lawn tennis, table tennis, kho-kho, hockey, march past, 5,000 m. race, 3,000 m. race, and carom etc. Besides participation in the normal activities of Sports and Games in the campus, the students also participated in the national events like North Zone Football Tournament, North Zone Table Tennis Championship and Fifth National Wheel Chair Fencing Championship.



23. CENTRAL FACILITIES

(i) CENTRAL LIBRARY

The Central Library of the Institute houses 1,71,659 books and subscribes to 150 National and 27 International Journals. Approximately 5,000 e-journals and 5 data bases are available through INFLIBNET. 4 data bases have been purchased for Engineering & Management. During the session 2012-13, 1200 more books have been added to the library. The Library Catalogue is computerized with bar code system. The transaction of the books is fully computerized. The computerization has been achieved by Library staff on their own using an open source software, called 'NEWGENLIB'.

(ii)COMPUTER CENTRE

The Centre provides laboratory facility for Information technology related classes of various certificates, diplomas, undergraduate and post graduate of faculty of Arts, Commerce, Education, Science, Social Sciences in addition to various vocational courses for students of Technical College and Women Polytechnic. Special courses are organized for unemployed youth by the Alumni Association. The Centre also organizes special course for new entrants to the University and special courses for Science and Engineering students are organized on latest fields of development like Android and windows application Development.

The other activities of the centre include development of Software for various functions of the University, management of Campus LAN & Internet linkages and leased lines to satellite campuses.

(iii) MULTIMEDIA LABORATORY

A state-of-the-art Multimedia Laboratory housing cameras, projection systems, video/editing stations amongst other equipment, provides a central point where the Institute generates content for its distance education programmes. This facility is also used on a regular basis to receive and transmit live lectures, and hold interactive sessions with students in remote classrooms both in India and abroad on a regular basis.

(iv) USIC

The University Science and Instrumentation Centre (USIC) comprises of three sections: Electronics, Mechanical and Glass Blowing. The centre undertakes repair, maintenance, design, fabrication, and upgradation work for the entire Institute. Besides this it offers training programmes for students and staff through regular short courses and advanced work experience courses on Computers and Peripherals and Basic Scientific Glass Blowing. At present, a Virtual Instrumentation facility is also being developed at the centre.

(v) NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS CENTRE AND CANTEEN

There is a Non-Resident Students Centre for Girls which serves as a composite Reading Room-cum-Common Room-cum-Canteen for the spare time needs of the female day scholars. For male students, there is canteen facility in the Campus.

(vi) MEDICAL AND HEALTH CARE

The students and staff of the Institute are attended to by the Medical Officer of the Saran Ashram Hospital, Dayalbagh, and are administered treatment for ordinary ailments without charges. The Hospital has provision for pathological testing, diathermy and ECG etc., on payment of charges.

(vii) DEI SEMINAR COMPLEX AND CONTINUING EDUCATION FACULTY HOSTEL

The hostel consist of 16 guest rooms, a seminar hall with 300 seating capacity, committee room and dining hall. The campus is equipped with Wi-fi and networking facility.

24. THIRTY-FIRST CONVOCATION

The Thirty-First Convocation of the Institute was held on January 12, 2013 in the Convocation Hall of the Institute. Shri A.K. Thakur, IAS, Secretary, Department of Higher Education, MHRD, New Delhi was the Chief Guest. Prof. V.G. Das, Director of the Institute, presented the annual report which was followed by the conferring of degrees and diplomas on the students of Undergraduate and Postgraduate classes besides Ph.D. awards. The meritorious students were awarded medals for their excellent achievements in various examinations of the Institute. The President of the Institute, Shri Prem Kumar, IAS (Retd.) gave away the medals. The Convocation was presided over by the President. The Chief Guest delivered the Convocation Address.


25. INSTITUTE FINANCE

Source-wise number of Research Projects awarded during 2012-13


