Candidates who had applied for various certificate and modular programs and had attended the counseling session on August 1, 2016 have been assigned certificate and modular program based on the order of merit, the preferences submitted by the candidates during counseling and the number of vacant seats available in various programs under different categories.

Candidates who had attended counseling are required to report for registration and verification of original documents for consideration of admission for the session 2016-2017 at 11 am on Saturday, August 6, 2016. All female candidates should report at the DEI Women's Polytechnic (Near Dayalbagh Post Office) and all male candidates should report at the DEI Tannery Complex. Only the applicant will be allowed at the Registration session and no other person will be permitted to accompany the applicant. Candidates are strongly advised to ensure timely attendance at the registration venue.

Candidates will be required to satisfy the respective Coordinator for the course to which they seek admission, through presentation of original documents, caste certificate, etc. that the applicant fulfills the eligibility criteria for the programme and that the details provided in the application from are correct. The applicants should also fulfill the following conditions:

- 1. The applicant produces his/her original certificates and testimonials, including caste certificate, etc. for further verification. In case of any discrepancy being discovered at any stage, the applicant may be disqualified.
- 2. If admitted, the applicant registers and deposits the fee prescribed for their respective program before the notified deadline.
- 3. If admitted, the applicant enrolls himself/herself in the Institute on the registration date. The Transfer/Migration certificate issued by the Institution last attended must be submitted within 15 days from the date of registration.
- 4. If admitted, the applicant starts attending regular classes from the date notified at the time of registration. If he/ she is absent for more than seven days in the first two weeks of commencement of regular classes, it will be assumed that the candidate has withdrawn from the program.

Some candidates who attended the counselling session may not be assigned to a program because of their relative position in merit and the number of seats currently available in programs of their preference. However, requests for registration from such waitlisted candidates and requests for change in the initial allocation will be considered after the first round of registration, strictly in the order of merit, based upon the number of vacancies that may be available at that time.
