DEI celebrated its Founder Day on 31st January 2014 with great enthusiasm and fervour. It is celebrated in commemoration of its Founder Director Most Revered Gracious Huzur Dr. M.B. Lal Sahab which is also His Birth day.

The Founder's day is celebrated as an **Open Day** in which works and achievements of the students and departments are shown. Students show their work with different Models/Exhibits. The main attraction of this year was recitation of *path* from the Holy Book, *SantBaniSangrah* by students and faculty members of the Institute. This Book contains different *sabdas* or prayers of Saints like Kabir Sahab, Tulsi Sahab, Nanak Sahab, Paltu Sahab and Huzur Soamiji Maharaj. *SantBaniSangrah* is divided into two parts. From the first part, *dohas* (couplets) were recited whereas *path* was recited from the second part. The recitation of *path* was a continuous phenomenon from 8 am to 4.30 pm. On

this occasion, Chairman, Advisory Committee on Education and Spiritual Leader of the Radhasoami Faith, Most Revered Prof. Prem Saran Satsangi Sahab blessed everyone with His Gracious Presence.

The DEI Technical College became the centre of attraction on the Founder's Day as it organized an exhibition of models prepared by the students of the College. There were a total of about 50 models on display in various categories. Models with technical focus included those on Jet Engine, Hovercraft, Hydraulic Brake System, Motorized Four-stroke Engine of Bullet Motorcycle, Cutsection Two-stroke Engine of Bajaj Scooter, Transmission System, and Ignition System. Models depicting technology of common interest were on Domestic Refrigerator without using electricity, Pedaldriven Hacksaw, Pedal-driven Washing Machine, Economic and Ergonomic Water Supply Equipment, and Theo Jansen Mechanism. The latter are large assemblages of piping, wood, and wing-like sails among others and are able to move on their own, especially on sandy beaches. Models showing the latest advancements in technology included those on Magnetic Levitation Train, Mars Rover, and Solar Car.
