




DEI LIBRARY DISTRIBUTED SYSTEM

विश्वविद्यालय में अविरल नहीं हुई 'शोधगंगा'

डॉ. मीमराव आंबेडकर विश्वविद्यालय में शोध की गंगा अविरल नहीं हो पा रही है। विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग (यूजीसी) के शोधगंगा पोर्टल पर विवि की चंद पीएचडी थीसिस ही अपलोड हैं। जबिक विश्वविद्यालय को शोध से निकली ज्ञान की निदयों को शोधगंगा तक पहुंचाना था। यह स्थिति तब है जब विवि 2015 के बाद से अब तक हुए दीक्षांत समारोह में 1084 शोधार्थियों को पीएचडी की उपाधि प्रदान कर चुका है। यूजीसी ने शोधगंगा पोर्टल की

शोध कार्यों को अपलोड करने पर
ध्यान नहीं दिया।

2016 से सिर्फ २६ थीसिस अपलोड हुई

डॉ. भीमराव आंबेडकर विश्वविद्यालय ने शोधगंगा पर पीएचडी थीसिस अपलोड करने के लिए 2016 में एमओयू (सहमित पत्र) पर हस्ताक्षर किए। इसके बाद से विवि को पोर्टल पर थीसिस अपलोड करनी थी। इसमें एमओयू के बाद और पहले हुई थीसिस उपलोड होनी थी, लेकिन विश्वविद्यालय सिर्फ 26 थीसिस ही अपलोड कर पाया।

2015 के बाद नहीं हुई पीएचडी पूरी

डॉ. भीमराव आंबेडकर विश्वविद्यालय ने 2015 के बाद बेशक दीक्षांत. समारोह में सैकड़ों पीएचड़ी उपाधियां प्रदान कर दी हों, लेकिन शोधगंगा पर स्थिति कुछ और ही हैं। यूजीसी के शोधगंगा पोर्टल पर 2015 के बाद विवि ने कोई शोध कार्य पूरा ही नहीं दिखाया है। जबकि विवि ने 2016 से अब तक 674 पीएचड़ी उपाधियां दीक्षांत समारोह में शोधार्थियों को प्रदान की हैं।
