The University Sustainable Innovation Centre (USIC) and the Faculty of Social Sciences jointly offer an integrated course in PG Diploma in Waste Management & Social Entrepreneurship (PGDWM & SE) integrated with MBA in Waste Management & Social Entrepreneurship (WM & SE) since 2019.

Course Structure:

PG Diploma in Waste Management and Social Entrepreneurship (PGDWM & SE):

The course consists of four modules:

- The first three modules are common with the other MBA specialized programs offered by the Institute and the modules include Core subjects and Dissertations.
- The last (Fourth) module consists of Two Elective Theory Subjects including a paper on Research Methodology (RM) and a Dissertation (execution).

MBA in Waste Management & Social Entrepreneurship (WM & SE):

This course has eight modules (four modules completed as mentioned above in PGDWM & SE), the fifth and sixth modules are an internship-based program to be executed in villages along with one core subject in each module.

In the last two modules, student chooses subjects from an open basket of specialized courses like Business Models in Waste Management, Fundamentals and Applications of Waste Management, Food processing and waste management, digital manufacturing, etc. along with dissertation work.

Eligibility Criteria:

- DEI students having minimum threshold limit of CGPA in PGD WM & SE qualify for MBA (WM
 & SE) and can continue with next four modules and will be awarded a MBA degree.
- The course is offered mainly to the students who have successfully completed their three-year B.Voc. programme from DEI. However, B. Tech. Graduates of DEI may also apply and can be considered only on the vacant seats.

Admission Process:

- Academic merit of students of DEI in B.Voc. /B.Tech. (subject to a minimum threshold CGPA).
- All applicants must have to submit a project proposal/report on waste management of about 500 words. The report should be original with a self-declaration certificate for plagiarism free. The grades obtained in the project report submitted by the students will be considered in final merit.
- Group discussion and Personal Interview.
