- With the purpose of overall development of the students and to inculcate human values in them, two core courses are offered in different semesters, by Sanskrit Department for all UG Programmes in the Institute.
- Cultural Education: It gives pride in the national ethos so that one may not lose one's moorings.
- Comparative Study of Religions: Concepts of eastern, western religions and Modern Religious Movements are introduced to students so as to inculcate in them an attitude of tolerance and a sense of national integration besides inculcating moral and spiritual values. Two books on Bhartiya Sanskriti and Vishwa ke Vividh Dharma are published from DEI.
- Since the degree of M.A. is awarded in 'Sanskrit and Culture', various aspects of Indian culture such as Vedic Mathematics, Astrology, Epigraphy and Ayurveda are also being taught.
- UpVaid (Ayush –Sanskrit) is taught by Sanskrit department.
- One seminar in Sanskrit language is compulsory for B.A. Hons., M.A. and M. Phil. Students.
- Theology programme includes specific study of all the major religions of the world centering on subjects like Methodology of Science of religions, religion and science and religion and future of mankind etc.

- Annual curriculum feedback is obtained from the Board of studies experts.
- Feedback is obtained from students by Class committee.

- Experienced subject experts are involved in the review and up gradation of the curriculum. Course contents are regularly reviewed to include current topics and trends.
- □ Annual BOS ensures about 5-10 % course revision according to latest academic requirements.




