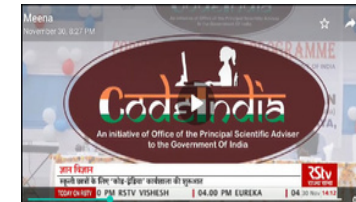


STUDENTS ACHIEVEMENT

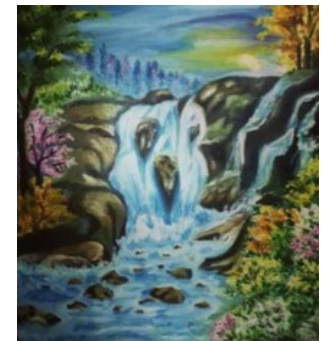

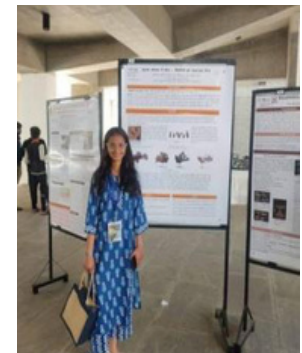
