1. What is the duration of the program?
3 years.
2. Is the program approved by AICTE?
We have AICTE approval for the on-campus MBA programme. As soon as AICTE is ready and invites application, we will process for approval in the distance mode.
3. What is the minimum percentage in graduation required for applying for this program?
55% in graduation for regular students. Relaxable by 10% reserved category students.
4. What are the placement opportunities after the program?
The faculty has a Training & Placement Cell (FTPC) . Both on campus and off campus placement opportunities are provided to the students.
5. Do we get opportunity for Internship in the program?

6. What are the various electives offered?
