
## Radhasoami.


In the context of the DEI team winning in the MIT COVID – 19 Challenge Hackathon, "India: Turning the Tide" was the theme of the hackathon described here. This was held during August 28-30, 2020, to develop innovative solutions that address the most pressing issues around the ongoing COVID -19 pandemic in India. The 48 hours online – only event drew wide participation of about 1400 participants and 300 mentors from across 30 countries, including several members of the Dayalbagh Educational Institute (DEI) (Deemed to be University). Among the teams from DEI that participated, the following 2 teams were adjudged winners in their respective tracks:

- 1. Team Docs@Home, led by Prof. K. Soami Daya (lady member) and
- 2. Team Whistle Winds led by Amolly Gupta, (New York Radhasoami Satsang Branch) and Prateesh, (DEI, Dayalbagh). Amolly Gupta is a female and Prateesh, I believe, is a male member.

After the detailed account of the measures taken by DEI (Deemed to be University) and the present status of the matter under consideration given by the President, Radhasoami Satsang Sabha, Dayalbagh, Agra and the DEI (Deemed to be University), the Director and the Registrar of DEI (Deemed to be University), the Chairman was further pleased to make the following observations:

That is why we wanted to be clear that Dr. Sam Pitroda's observations become a great morale booster and it is for Government of India to take note of it and preserve our forest cover and work for the poorest of the poor in terms of Scheduled Castes and Tribal populations such as in Rajaborari and Timarni in Madhya Pradesh, with which we have contact over a very long period of more than 40 years ever since formation of DEI as a Deemed to be University. So, President, Delhi Radhasoami Satsang Association for the Region identified as Delhi Region as well as Director, Delhi School of Economics, a very reputed and trustworthy organisation advising the Government regarding matters pertaining to the centres in the brain in the context of the meditational practice of 'Sahaj Surat Shabd Yog' as against the earlier prevalent 'Pranayam' which can take a person only upto the domain of Mind and not beyond that to Pure Thought or Pure Mind, Purer Mind, Purest Mind, which we describe as 'Pure Spirituality' in Radhasoami Faith. In view of the Special Meeting arranged on Video Conferencing network, i.e., Virtual Reality Mode, Dr. Sam Pitroda who had been the expert during the regime of Dr. Man Mohan Singh, a top-notch Economist well known all over the world, this is the latest evidence of how the Supreme Creator of the entire Universe crowns humble human efforts with Grand Success by bestowing HIS Infinite Grace and Mercy.
