REVIEW OF THEMATIC SESSIONS

She explained about nature of IPR, major IPR segments, IP Law of India, copyrights, patent etc. The session was very informative and created firsthand knowledge about IPR to students with some interesting quiz at the end to check the presence of participants. The students were also provided with a booklet which included details of the topics explained by the Resource Persons.

He gave detailed information about the technicality of patent filing, types of patent filing forms, and ways to rapid processing of patent application. He also informed about the fee structure and National Biodiversity Authority (NBA) approval; in case you are using any biological material. He also talked about what is patentable and what is non-patentable. The session was very informative and resource person explained the complexity of patent filing process in a very simple and interesting way. All participants enjoyed a lot.


