- 18. The Academic Council noted the minutes of the meeting dated 4.4.2014 of the Standing Committee of the Academic Council (Appendix-IV) regarding the following:-
 - (i) to introduce Summer improvement/remedial Courses for Honours and PG Classes;
 - (ii) to grant permission to Akshat Satsangi, student of B.Tech. VIII Semester who is also doing M.Tech. (Engineering System) in Integrated mode, for registering in the course CSM802- "Intelligent Information Processing";
 - (iii) (a) to introduce Co-op. Programme, comprising 3 months' Industrial Training for the Diploma in Automobile Engineering from the session 2014-15;
 - (b) to start a 10-Week Modular Programme on "Operation and Maintenance of Solar Power Plants";
 - (c) to start a Modular Programme on "Interior Decoration";
 - (iv) to permit students of B.A. and B.A. (Social Sciences) to opt any one major subject for their honours classes out of any two they studied during the first two years of their BA and BA (Social Sciences) and
 - (v) to permit part-time MBA students to complete their course in three years instead of three and half years, if they are employed or self-employed, provided they complete their practical training in the sixth semester.
- 19. The Academic Council noted that the Research Degree Committee of the Institute has approved registration of 36 students in the Ph.D. Programme of the Institute during the period from 30-OCT-2013 to 29-MAR-2014 (Appendix-V).

Any other items

The following items were considered in the meeting:-

20. The matter of permission to the temporary faculty members for doing Ph.D. in the Institute was considered.

Members noted that the permanent staff or the persons appointed on probation on the permanent posts of the Institute registered for Ph.D. degree will be treated as part-time research scholars and shall be required to put in a minimum of 3 calendar years from the date of their registration.

Members desired that this facility be also extended to temporary staff appointed for 1 year against permanent post.

Resolved that the proposal be and is hereby approved and the recommendations be made to the Governing Body for its approval.

21. The matter of admission in Master's programme in stream other than stream of Bachelor's degree was considered.

Members noted that it has been in the practice at the Institute to offer Master's Programme in the line with stream offered at Bachelor's programme. However, members were of the view that with increasing inter-disciplinary approach in higher education, it may be useful to permit admission in Master's programme in any stream other than the stream of Bachelors programme.

Resolved that the proposal be and is hereby approved and the recommendations be made to the Governing Body for its approval.

22. Adoption of major/honours in Bachelor for inter-faculty course was considered.

All students in the Institute admitted in Bachelor's courses (BA/BSc/BCom/BBM/BA(Social Sc.)/BSc (Home Sc) take up additional honours degree programme for two semesters after successfully completing first four semester.

The members were of the view that honours in Bachelor's course within 'Inter-faculty should also be permitted for interested students.

Resolved that the proposal be and is hereby approved and the recommendations be made to the Governing Body for its approval.

23. The matter of admission in M.Phil. programme in open mode was considered.

Members noted that in Semester Programme of M.Phil. is available for the students of various postgraduate courses of the Institute.

The members desired this benefit be also extended to the external candidates willing to take up M.Phil. programme as is available to students of the Institute.

Resolved that the proposal be and is hereby approved and the recommendations be made to the Governing Body for its approval.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
