Resolved further that in case any other candidate(s) completes the requirements for the Ph.D. degree and the Results Committee clears the award before the ensuing Convocation, the Chairman of the Academic Council be and is hereby authorised to approve the award of degree of Doctor of Philosophy to such candidate(s).

- 9(a) Considered for approval the formats (Appendix-IV) of the following Degrees/ Diplomas to be conferred in the ensuing Convocation:-

10. The Academic Council noted that the XXXVI Convocation of the Institute will be held on 21.4.2018 and Hon'ble Prof. Rajiv Kumar, Vice-Chairman, NITI Ayog, Government of India, New Delhi has given his consent to be the Chief Guest.

ANY OTHER ITEMS

1. The Academic Council noted nine research divisions have been identified and these will work and operate from the session, July 2018. The details regarding these divisions are enclosed herewith. Each division shall be headed by a Chairperson for a duration of three years. The Institute shall provide seed money to each division which shall be interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary in nature. The members of each division will be involved in the research areas associated with that division and will apply for funding through research proposals, to sustain the division.
2. The Academic Council noted that the infrastructure seed money shall be provided to members of Institute in consultation with a committee appointed by the Director. The funding shall be approved based on return on investment.
3. Considered the recommendation of the Honorary Degree Committee for the conferment of the degree of Doctor of Letters [D.Litt.(Honoris Causa)] or Doctor of Science [D.Sc.(Honoris Causa)]. The Academic Council in its meeting held on 19.4.2018 empowered the Director to present the list of nominations before the Governing Body.
4. The Academic Council noted the following order of the Director -

"In view of the hot season dress for male members in the Convocation is approved as white shirt with blue tie and white pant/off-white pant/cream pant in place of closed collar white coat and white pant with appropriate cape as prescribed (approved by the Governing Body vide its resolution no.5 dated 11.9.1982)."
