The approval of the new courses in DEI will ensure that the academic standards are maintained. The approval procedures are subject to internal and external review. Due consideration is given to the availability of resource material, the coherence and academic standard of constituent courses. The courses mentioned above have been approved through their respective Board of Studies and the Faculty Board. After screening all the presentations, resolved that the following Committee be and is hereby constituted for implementation in a phased manner & in modular form.

 - (3) One member of Academic Council (to be nominated by the Director)
 - (4) One member from Industry (to be nominated by the Director)

14. The Academic Council noted that Central Council of Homoeopathy (a Statutory Body) under the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India vide its letter F.No.15-5/2017-CCH (29)/23322 dated 29.11.2017 has issued a Letter of Intent (LoI) in favour of the Institute to start a new Homoeopathic Medical College in the name and style "DEI Faculty of Integrated Medicine (AYUSH) Homoeopathy Medical College, Dayalbagh Educational Institute, Dayalbagh, Agra-282005, U.P." with 50 seats in BHMS Course from the academic year 2018-19.
15. The Academic Council noted that UGC vide its notification dated 4.5.2016 and 11.7.2016 has issued 3rd and 4th amendments respectively in respect of minimum qualification and Academic Performance Indicator (API) for Career Advancement Scheme of teachers, which may now be called the University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointments of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) (4th amendment), Regulations 2016.
16. The Academic Council noted that -
UGC vide its letter No.4-10/2014(NSQF/Kaushal) dated 21.8.2017 has given permission to start the following courses under the scheme of Deen Dayal Upadhyay Kaushal Kendra:-

1. Considered the following proposals submitted by of the Head, Department of Management, Faculty of Social Sciences. These have been recommended by the Board of Studies and Faculty Board:-

 - (3) Introduction of a certificate course on Financial Services through Distance Education Programme.

2. Considered the amendments proposed in the syllabi for the following courses of studies offered by the Faculty of Education for the session 2018-2019 and introduction of new courses, if any, as submitted by various Boards of Studies and the Faculty of Education as per provisions of Bye-law No.4(iii) and 2(iii) :
- i) D.El.Ed.
 - ii) B.Ed.
 - iii) M.Ed.
 - iv) M.Phil (Education)

Resolved that the item be deferred for the next meeting.

3. Considered the proposal of Prof. K. Shanti Swarup, Department of Management, Faculty of Social Sciences seeking approval for starting M.Phil. (Part-time) in Journalism and Mass Communication in collaboration with Madhubala Institute of Communication and Electronic Media, New Delhi.

Resolved that the item be deferred for the next meeting.

4. Considered the proposal of the Coordinator, B.Voc. Renewable Energy seeking approval for the course structure of B.Voc. Renewable Energy VI Semester and M.Voc. II Semester.

Resolved that the item be deferred for the next meeting.

5. Considered the amendments proposed in the syllabi of the Department of Sociology and Political Science, Faculty of Social Sciences approved by the Board of Studies and Faculty Board.

Resolved that the item be deferred for the next meeting.

6. Considered the proposal for adopting UGC (Credit Framework for online courses through SWAYAM) Regulations 2016 and the UGC (Credit Framework for online course through SWAYAM) Regulations 2016 (First Amendment). The student can credit courses on SWAYAM and the credits earned can be given equivalent weightage by the Institute.

Resolved that the item be deferred for the next meeting.

7. Considered the proposal to start a new compulsory course on "Safety & Maintenance Network".

In today's scenario safety and security challenges rank among the most pressing issues in academic institutions. It is proposed that all the students who are admitted to this institution must be sensitised about the safety and security measures in the campus.

It has been further decided that a detailed syllabus be prepared in which emphasis be given to traffic safety and work place safety. It was also emphasised that a separate course for Pre-Nursery (3 months to 3 years), Nursery, Primary, PV & REI Inter College be prepared. It was suggested that the course be included in the I semester with sufficient demonstration features.

8. Considered the proposal of the Coordinator, Primary Education Section, Dayalbagh for starting semester system in P.V. Primary School, Dayalbagh.

Resolved that the proposal be and is hereby approved.

9. Considered the proposal to hold a common entrance test for all B.Voc. Courses.

The members suggested that there should be a common written entrance test for all the B. Voc. Programmes.

It was further suggested that to promote growth opportunities for Supporting Staff of the Institute and give them a vertical mobility they be allowed to join B. Voc. Courses if they fulfill the following criteria:

- (a) 8th pass with 4 years of experience in the same skill.
- (b) 10th pass with 2 years of experience in the same skill.

Resolved that the proposal as above be and is hereby approved.

10. Considered the matter that some students of the Institute approach the teachers with a request to issue them a certificate for their performance in a particular field and some teachers have issued such certificates in individual capacity. The students use these certificates signed by individual teachers to claim additional weightage from the Institute to enhance their merit.

Members were of the opinion that certificates for individual performance should not be issued by the individual teachers. It would be proper that certificates should be issued by the competent authority e.g. Dean / Principal of concerned Faculty/ College countersigned by the Head of the Department/ Course /Cultural Coordinator. These events such as, performance given by the students during NSS, Youth Parliament, Youth Festival, Convocation and during visits of dignitaries to the Institute on special occasions etc. should be open to all students.

Resolved that Dean/Principal be and is hereby authorized to issue certificates of various performances which are open to all the students on the recommendation of Head of the Department/Cultural Coordinator/Course Coordinator and these certificates be treated as valid for conferring accolades on the students.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
