Progress of the Association from 01.01.2013 to 31.12.2013

The Association, as on 31st December, 2013, has 1,799 Ordinary Members and 2,377 Associate Members, totalling 4,176 members.

The members have generously contributed to the Corpus of the Association for its objectives. The Corpus contribution has been invested in interest bearing Fixed Deposits in Banks.

The income has been utilised for its objectives in the period under review by giving contribution to the following activities:

- Expansion of Buildings of R.S. Saran Ashram School Society, Dayalbagh.

- Development of "AADEIs Transit Home" at Manglam Estate, Dayalbagh.

Setting up more such ICT Centres in other parts of the country in future is under consideration.
