REPORT OF THE SECRETARY
Progress of the Association from 01.01.2016 to 31.12.2016

The Association, as on 31st December, 2016, has 1,862 Ordinary Members and 2,484 Associate Members, totalling 4,346 members.

The members have generously contributed to the Corpus of the Association for its objectives. The Corpus contribution has been invested in interest bearing Fixed Deposits in Banks.

The income has been utilised for its objectives in the period under review by giving contribution inter alia for the following activities:

- 1) To Middle India Radhasoami Education Society towards construction of Primary School, Recreation Centre and Community Hall etc. in Tribal area of Madhya Pradesh.
- 2) To Dayalbagh Educational Institute for:
 - i) ISO 9001 Certification Programme.
 - ii) TSC 2016.
 - iii) Starting of an Information Centre at Kochi (Kerala).
- 3) To Tamil Radhasoami Education Society for construction of the School Building at MTV Puram.
- 4) Under Graduate Research Award scheme (UGRA).
- 5) To Job Fair Programme for Noida.

The programmes of DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Soami Nagar, New Delhi, and DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Bangalore have grown substantially and these now also help run a number of DEI courses. AADEIs is contributing the expenditure on running these Centres.

Courses which help the students and job seekers in placement and otherwise are being conducted regularly at AADEIs ICT Continuing Education Centre DEI, Dayalbagh, and a large number of students of DEI, Distance Education Centres, alumni and unemployed youth have benefited from these.

Since November 1, 2016, the administration of AADEIs ICT-Centres, and the staff deployed in these, has been passed on to DEI.

The Executive Committee is proposing to open new Chapters of the Association in various parts of the Country. This will enable large number of Alumni to join and contribute in the progress of the Institutions of Dayalbagh.

The Alumni Placement Assistance Cell (APAC) of AADEIs continues to conduct its training and placement programmes such as job fairs for students, alumni and other unemployed youth with commendable vigour.

Your Executive Committee places on record its appreciation of the excellent work being done by the Administrators at DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Soami Nagar, New Delhi, AADEIs ICT Continuing Education Centre DEI, Dayalbagh and DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Bangalore.
