REPORT OF THE SECRETARY Progress of the Association from 01.01.2017 to 31.12.2017

The Association, as on 31st December, 2017, has 1,874 Ordinary Members and 2,502 Associate Members, totalling 4,376 members.

The members have for its objectives, generously contributed to the Corpus of the Association which has been invested in interest bearing Fixed Deposits and 8% Savings (Taxable) Bonds.

The income has been utilised, in the period under review for its objectives by giving contribution inter alia for the following activities:

- To Dayalbagh Educational Institute for:
 - i) Operation and maintenance of existing e-Classroom / multimedia infrastructure programme and web maintenance.
 - ii) The Science of Consciousness Conference (TSC) 2017.
 - iii) Upgradation of ISO 9001-2015 standards in DEI.
 - iv) Under Graduate Research Award Scheme (UGRA).
 - v) Various ongoing activities i.e. construction of workshop for diploma courses at Timarni, class room for agriculture technology course, construction of central studio and drawing studio, construction of battery room in dairy complex etc.
- To Managing Committee of Radhasoami Educational Institute of Agra for M.P. towards construction of Studio Apartments at Satsang Hall Compound at Timarni (M.P.).

Besides above your association has committed funds to Tamil Radhasoami Education Society towards completion of 2nd phase of school building at MTV Puram, Tamilnadu.

The Alumni Placement Assistance Cell (APAC) of AADEIs continues to conduct its training and placement programmes such as job fairs for students, alumni and other unemployed youth. A DEI – AADEIs Alumni Meet was successfully organised at IIT Delhi on 12th November, 2017. It has generated lots of enthusiasm amongst the alumni. Your Executive Committee has decided to encourage and co-opt alumni who are not attached to Dayalbagh as honorary members to assist in various professional activities with focus on academic support and placement activity by enlarging the enabler base.

A Civil Services Training Programme (CSTP) has been started by AADEIs in distance and face to face mode. The Executive Committee places on record its gratitude to the Radhasoami Satsang Sabha and M.C. of REI of Dayalbagh for making available the premises at New Day Boarding School, Dayalbagh, for office-cum-training facility for this programme. Out of about 200 applications, 37 students, comprising 24 girls and 13 boys, were selected from across India for the programme. The students have shown high degree of involvement and engagement with the course. The first assessment test was held in end November, 2017, in which 34 students had participated. Based on the approval received from the Advisory Committee on Education (ACE), a six day face to face training programme is being organised during the last week of December, 2017.
