Dr. Anand Kr. Pallapaly from IIT Jodhpur told about G- Filter for water purification which was fabricated by his research group using clay and sawdust. He told that this technology is cost effective and any potter can make it. Another talk given by Dr. Sanjeev Saxena, Head, Jaypee Hotel Training Center, Agra, focused upon the small measures they are practicing in their hotels to conserve water. During the second session, Er. Lalit M. Sharma, Director SM Sehgal Foundation, advised about the conservation and storage of rain-water without mixing it with saline ground water. This technique is also cost effective and the foundation provides help in the setup of this method at various places. Head of Ganga River Basin Project, Prof. Vinod Tare, IIT Kanpur, suggested about the policy of zero waste discharge in water bodies, reuse/recycle more seriously. Mr. S. Ahuja told about the water conservation programme running in Dayalbagh.
