## Visit of Director Higher Education & Skilling, MHRD

Mrs. Suhasini Gotmare, Director, Higher Education and Skilling, MHRD, visited DEI on 9 May, 2019. The visit was focused on orienting Mrs. Gotmare towards the education initiatives at DEI, especially the skilling programmes i.e. the 18 Bachelors in Vocational Studies programmes, and their outcomes, as well as acceptance by the student groups and industry. The visit commenced with a trip to the fields at *Chand Marhi ka Tila*, where Mrs. Gotmare met Revered Professor P.S. Satsangi Sahab, Chairman, Advisory Committee on Education, DEI and it was discussed that the skilling initiatives at DEI may be modeled in other places.

Mrs. Gotmare visited the Dayalbagh Colony, the Exhibitions on the History of DEI and Core Courses, the PV Primary School, the Atal Tinkering Lab and Fold Scope demo at PV Intermediate College, Polytechnic, the Nano and Consciousness Center, (i-cn-c) Tall Language Lab, DEI Creche, Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Integrated Medicine and the Dayalbagh Dairy.

An interactive session with ICT and Learning





centers at Murar in Bihar, Rajaborari in Madhya Pradesh, MTV Puram in Tamil Nadu as well as Coordinating Faculty of the Bachelors in Vocational Courses at DEI was organized in the Multi-media facility Lab. The Co-ordinators introduced their courses, and presented the placement outcomes of the courses in which the students had passed out. The role of the Alumni network in placing students, as well as strategic corporate partnerships was emphasized. Mrs. Gotmare also interacted with students at various centers through the ICT network.

Mathematical Sciences and Applications" on April 20, 2019.

Prof. Ravi Kulkarni (Founder President TIMC, Former Director, HRI Allahabad) delivered lecture on Philosophy of Mathematics.

Many other renowned professors from different universities also delivered lectures in the workshop. Some of them are: Prof. Karmeshu (President TIMC, Shiv Nadar Univ.), Prof. S.A. Katre (Pune Univ.), Prof.V.P. Saxena (Ex. Vice Chacellor Jivaji Univ. Gwalior), Prof. V.D. Pathak (M.S. Univ. Baroda), Prof. Shalabh Bhatnagar (IISc. Bangalore).

Lectures were also delivered by Prof. C Patvardhan (Engineering Faculty) and Prof. Gur Saran, Prof. Gunjan Agarwal and Prof. Shiroman Prakash (Science Faculty) of DEI.

### Workshop on Fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence

A Ten-day Workshop on 'Fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence' organized by the School of Education (SoE) Project (Faculty of Education) under the aegis of Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of MHRD commenced on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019 with the inaugural address by Prof Gur Saran Adhar, Professor, University of North Carolina on 'Artificial Intelligence-In the service of Education' dealing with the various paradigms of Artificial Intelligence. He discussed the AI techniques of Supervised and Unsupervised Learning, Cluster Analysis, Association, etc. and how they supplement the teaching process. In the first session, Dr Manu Pratap Singh, Department of Computer Science, Dr. B R Ambedkar University, Agra discussed the recent developments in

Information Technology and the various applications of AI viz; Natural Language Understanding, Visual Scene Analysis, Common Sense reasoning, Action Planning, Expert Problem Solving and Learning. In the concluding session the essential components of an AI system were explained with practical examples. The workshop envisages an orientation to the field of AI and its applications in the Education System.160 Participants included enthusiastic 31 School Teachers, Teacher Educators and Students and Staff of the University. The sessions included interactive discussions on Ethics of AI, Machine Learning, Data Analysis, Robotics and other applications of AI to Teaching. The workshop has been convened by Dr Neha Jain and Ms. Mugdha Sharma under the Centre for Artificial Intelligence, School of Education, DEI.

## Library Kiosk facilities developed at DEI Faculty of Integrated Medicine (AYUSH)

The AYUSH Central Library at DEI Faculty of Integrated Medicine (AYUSH) has now adopted innovative technologies like "Library Kiosk and Pattern Control System" to deliver self-service facilities, namely Self-Check-out, Self Check-in and information searching kiosk to serve the teachers, researchers and students efficiently. The self-service facilities enable the faster and more efficient way of searching, borrowing and returning of books. The AYUSH Library has become the first library to implement library kiosk facilities in DEI to disseminate information using a self- service tool. The library kiosk is equipped with touch screen, smart card, barcode, QR code and biometrics technologies for instant use of library resources by users at the single platform. The library users are availing these facilities through biometrics and barcode technologies in the AYUSH library. The library has a rich collection of more than 3000 books and journals in mainly Homeopathic and allied

medicine disciplines. To implement the library kiosk at AYUSH library, Mr. B.P. Singh, Faculty Librarian has taken an initiative under the guidance of Prof. M.M. Srivastava, Coordinator, DFIM and Dr Rajnesh Sharma, Principal, Homoeopathic Medical College, DEI, Agra.
