100 Years of Education Celebrated with *Joie de vivre*

Articles developed by students in various courses were displayed which included, Preserved and Processed food items (Pickles, Jam etc.), Teaching aids for pre-school children, and garments designed and developed under Clothing & Textiles. A survey on the life satisfaction among students of DEI was also conducted by the Human Development

SAMPRAVAH-'16The Tech-Entrepreneurship Festival Organized

As Dayalbagh Educational Institute is celebrating 100 years of education in Dayalbagh, keeping in tune with it the special edition of SAMPRAVAH- the Tech-Entrepreneurship Festival integrating all the faculties of the institute, was organised from April 13-18, 2016 by Faculty of Science. SAMPRAVAH is a platform for the students to develop their skills and showcase their technological aptitude and scientific abilities. With the theme of Innovation and technology, the FEST featured 31 events divided into 8 tracks and 3 workshops. These eight tracks were Logical Thinking & General Awareness, Creativity, Innovation, Business/Entrepreneurship, Science Technology, IT/Programming, Verbal/Communication Skills, gaming and three workshops on Photography, Android App Development, and Stock Market Tricks. The events 'Decrypto', 'Take-A-Break', 'The NOT-SO-GK Quiz', 'Muggle or Wizard', and 'Treasure Hunt' were organised for students to test their cognizance potential. Total 599

students participated in these competitions. 'That's What I'am' was an on the spot t-shirt painting competition in which students had to depict their artistic impressions. In the event 'Documentary Making' students had to portray a story using photographs without words. 'POETica' was another interesting event in which students had to express their feelings with pen in the form of poetry based on the topic which was given on the spot. The events organised under this category were: 'Waste-A-Loons', 'Udaan', 'Junkyard Wars', and 'Goldberg's Machine'. In Udaan, students created paper based architecture of flying machine and tested them. In order to promote entrepreneurship, there were events like 'Start up Bench' and 'Stock Trading'. Under Verbal/Communication Skills and Gaming Categories, six events 'Lingua Complexica', 'Ahvaan', 'Burnout', 'Brain Games', 'Make it or Break It' and 'Dubsmash King' were arranged.
