New Facilities Generated:

Measurements of invisible particles at DEI, Dayalbagh

MWR (Multiwavelength Radiometer): MWR measures aerosol optical depth (AOD) at 10 wavelengths in the ambient atmosphere. MWR derives AOD from measurements of direct solar irradiance, using a set of calibration constants for each wavelength. The obtained AODs at total of 10 wavelengths can be

utilized to retrieve the wavelength exponent, which is an index of aerosol size distribution.

Aethalometer: This instrument simultaneously samples and measures the mass concentration of black carbon particles in the air. It gives real time particle concentration and measures light absorption by suspended aerosol particles at seven wavelengths, from 370 nm (UV) to 950 nm (IR). This instrument assists in identifying the primary components.
