XXXIII Convocation of the Institute

The 33rd Convocation of the Institute was held on Jan. 3, 2015 at its Convocation Hall. The event coinciding with the celebrations of the Centenary Year of the foundation of Dayalbagh Colony, was marked with elegance and vigour. The Chief Guest of the programme was Shri Satya N. Mohanty, I.A.S, Secretary (Higher Education), MHRD, New-Delhi. The event was presided over by Shri Prem Kumar, IAS (Retd.), Honourable President of the Institute. 2095 students were awarded Degrees for the various examinations passed in the year 2014, while 402 students were awarded Diplomas and 263 students

received Certificates on this occasion. 90 students were presented the Director's Medal and two received





the President's Medal. In the last Category. 57 students were awarded Ph.D. Degrees in different subjects.

Prof. P.K. Kalra, Director, DEI, presented the report of the Institute's achievements during the outgoing session. He also highlighted the aim of the Institute to develop as a Centre of Excellence.

While delivering his Convocation Address, Shri Mohanty highly praised the scheme of Innovative and Comprehensive education introduced in DEI. He was particularly impressed by the endeavours taken up by the Institute to impart holistic education in view of evolving the 'Complete Man'.

Distinguished Alumni Award:

The highlight of the Convocation was the conferring of the Distinguished Alumni Award for the year 2014 on Prof. Sant Saran Bhojwani.

Professor Sant Saran Bhojwani was born on Nov. 20, 1940 in Dayalbagh. After obtaining early education in Dayalbagh, he completed M.Sc. in Botany from Agra University in 1963 with flying colours. He served his Alma Mater, i.e., REI Degree College, Dayalbagh, for a year, and then moved to the University of Delhi and obtained Ph.D. degree in 1968.

Professor Bhojwani is an international authority in Plant Biotechnology and has made pioneering contributions in this area. He has published over 100 papers in reputed international journals and 21 invited chapters in books. He has also authored or edited 8 books published by reputed international publishers.

Professor Bhojwani has been a recipient of prestigious awards and fellowships that include the S. Navashin Memorial Medal by USSR, British Council Visitorship, Royal Society Commonwealth Bursary and Senior JSPS Fellowoship to university of Tokyo.

In 2002, Professor Bhojwani took voluntary retirement from the University of Delhi to serve the Dayalbagh Educational Institute as its Director till the year 2005. He is presently actively involved in Educational and Agricultural activities in Dayalbagh, as Secretary of a number of Educational Societies and Technical & Financial Adviser of the Agriculture Farm.

Republic Day Celebrations

The 66th Republic Day was celebrated at DEI Main Campus in all its solemnity and grandeur. The
