CALL FOR CONTRIBUTED TALKS AND POSTERS

Abstracts of contributed talks or posters presenting new and original research in Consciousness Studies, either experimental or theoretical, are sought. Criteria of evaluation are novelty of ideas, rigorous scientific/academic methodology, acknowledgment of international research pertaining to the topic, analytical clarity, and potential for publication in a reputed journal.

TOPICS OF INTEREST

- Models, concepts, and representations of consciousness in the sciences, humanities, and arts, but also in different religions, cultures, ethnicities;
- Research and discussions pertaining to Consciousness Studies in specific academic disciplines like Neuroscience, Philosophy, Psychology, Mathematics, Computer Science, Literary and Cultural Studies, Engineering, the Arts, Physics, Theology, Comparative Religious Studies, History, etc.
- The potential, problems and limits of the respective methodologies of specific disciplines for Consciousness Studies;
- Interdisciplinary approaches to and models of consciousness;
- The scientific investigation and evaluation of meditation, religion, spirituality, and first-person experiences for Consciousness Studies
- Machine consciousness;
- Consciousness and cultural context;
- Consciousness and the body/biology;
- Consciousness and ethics;
- Consciousness and mind/intellect; etc.

The contributed talks will be **max. 10 minutes** each.

The abstract of Contributed Talks should be - written in **English**, not longer than **max. 1 DIN-A-4 page, 12-point** or larger fonts, single-column, 1,5 space between lines, with ample spacing throughout and 1-inch margins all around (longer abstracts will not be considered!).

The Posters should be submitted in final form as **1 DIN-A-4 page**.

The Programme Committee may designate up to three contributed papers and up to three posters accepted for the conference as DSC 2022 Best Papers resp. Best Posters.
