- **A. Introduction:** The Faculty of Education organized the workshop under the aegis of the Association of Indian Universities-Dayalbagh Educational Institute Academic & Administrative Development Centre (AIU-DEI-AADC) collaboration. The workshop aimed to promote the ethical conduct of academicians in research and publication. A total of 109 university participants registered for the workshop, which was conducted in hybrid mode.
- **B.** Objective of the Workshop: The primary objective of the workshop was to engage researchers, academics, and students in a detailed discussion on the ethical practices essential for maintaining research integrity, addressing the challenges posed by predatory publications, and understanding the tools available to navigate the complex world of academic research.


