An Exhibition on the Dayalbagh Educational Institute at London, United Kingdom

On Saturday 7th June 2025, a DEI Exhibition was held at London, United Kingdom, as a part of an Open Day Celebration on Dayalbagh. 120 people visited. Visitors were impressed with the value based education at DEI and the 4Ls policy (the Last, the Lost, the Least and the Lowest) which enables those from disadvantaged backgrounds to access quality education from kindergarten to degree level & beyond. It was heartening for people to learn that of 14,000 students 70% are female and that the girls often return to their villages after gaining qualifications to setup entrepreneurial units and enable other women to gain skills and earn a livelihood.

Visitors were impressed by the range and quality of research conducted at DEI and the high number of patents. It was astonishing for them to learn that DEI also has MOUs with top universities across the globe and hosts international conferences e.g. the Dayalbagh Science of Counsciousness (DSC). The long list and pictures of eminent personalities, such as Sir Roger Penrose, to have visited and showered praise on DEI was noteworthy.

Visitors also commended the focus on skilling and empowering of women, demonstrations of self defence PT and servings of delicious sweets and savouries cooked by them. Their excellent embroidery and creative skills were also evident in a wonderful display of a range of handloom and handicraft items.

A model of Dayalbagh was displayed highlighting the importance of Agroecology cum Precision Farming. The focus on Agroecology cum Precision Farming as an integral part of the DEI student curriculum and as specialised degree level courses was greatly appreciated.
