Re-launch of MOOC (Community Engagement and Social Responsibility)

The third cycle of the MOOC *Community Engagement and Social Responsibility*, developed by Dayalbagh Educational Institute, was launched by the Honorable Chairman, UGC, on September 2, 2024. The course enrolled 12,004 learners from six countries, 29 Indian states, and three union territories. Seven interactive online sessions were conducted with learners on Sundays.

The Food and Nutrition Counter, set up during the Free Medical and Rural Assistance Camp, focuses on improving rural health, particularly for underprivileged children in these villages.

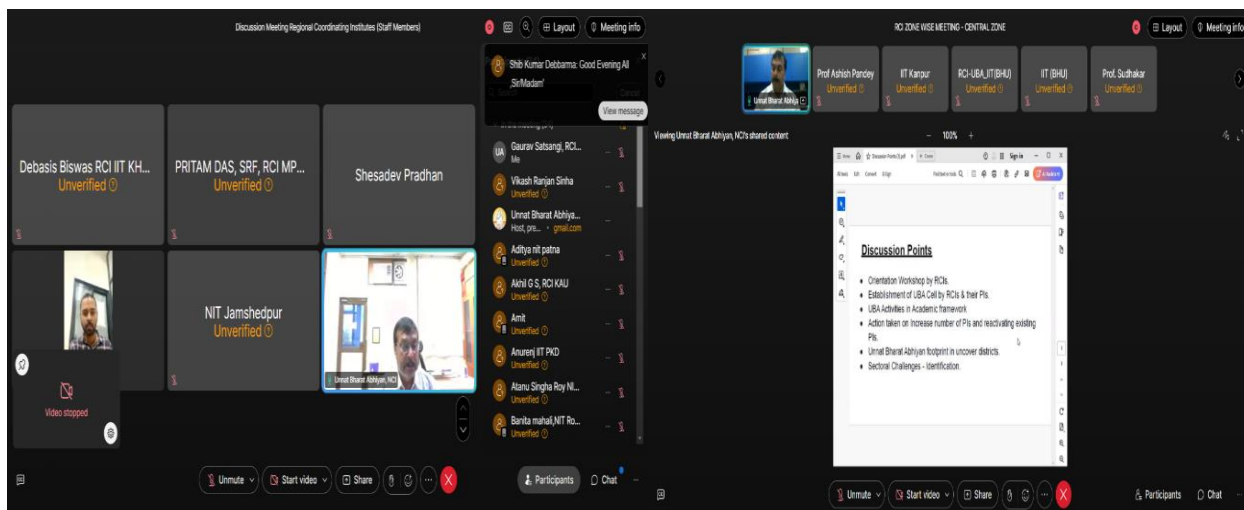


Interactive Meeting with National Coordinating Institute (IIT Delhi)

On September 2, 2024, an interactive meeting was conducted between the National Coordinating Institute (IIT Delhi) and Regional Coordinating Institutes (RCIs) to deliberate on key aspects of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA). The discussion centered around the following agenda points:

1. **Orientation Workshop by RCIs:** Discussion on conducting workshops to strengthen the implementation of UBA initiatives.
2. **Establishment of UBA Cell:** Strategies for setting up UBA Cells within RCIs and their Participating Institutes (PIs).
3. **Integration of UBA Activities in the Academic Framework:** Exploring ways to incorporate UBA initiatives into the academic curriculum.
4. **Enhancing PI Engagement:** Review of actions taken to increase the number of Participating institutes and revitalize inactive ones.
5. **Expanding UBA's Reach:** Efforts to extend UBA's impact to uncovered districts.

The meeting emphasized collaborative efforts to strengthen the implementation and outreach of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan.



SWAYAM Orientation Session

On September 2, 2024, an online SWAYAM meeting was held to enhance understanding of the examination process for various Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) offered across India on the SWAYAM platform.

The Ministry of Education has assigned the National Testing Agency (NTA) the responsibility of conducting external examinations for all MOOCs available on the SWAYAM platform.

As part of this process, the NTA requires two distinct sets of Question Papers along with their corresponding Answer Keys. In the current examination cycle, the NTA has decided to develop these question papers through an online platform called **E-Sulekh**, which facilitates both question paper creation and moderation.

Course Coordinators will provide the Questions and Answer Keys on the E-Sulekh platform, while a panel of experts, designated by the National Coordinator, will oversee the moderation process. During the meeting, detailed guidelines were shared regarding the procedures for conducting the proctored examination, which will be administered by the National Testing Agency, (NTA) at various exam centers across India.
