Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

- The 4 Year ITEP is a milestone achievement in fulfilling one of the major mandates of National Education Policy 2020. The course will contribute substantially to the revitalization of the whole teacher education sector. The prospective teachers passing out of this course through a multi-disciplinary environment, grounded in Indian values and traditions will be instilled with the needs of 21st century on global standards, and hence will be largely helpful in shaping the future of New India.
- The four-year ITEP will be available for all students who choose teaching as a profession after secondary, by choice. This integrated course will benefit students since they will save one year by finishing it in four years rather than the customary five years required by the present B.Ed. The admission will be carried out by NCTE with the help of National Testing Agency (NTA) through the National Common Entrance Test.

Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

- This is a specialised course with intrinsic integration of pedagogy and content, along with sustained engagement with liberal disciplines of knowledge and field of education.

The ITEP aims at the dual purpose of providing student teachers disciplinary knowledge along with the professional knowledge in an integrated manner. Since the program will be equivalent to an Undergraduate Degree (B.Sc./B.A./ B.Com.) and Teacher Education Degree, the curriculum of this program includes different courses and activities essential for both the degrees.

फा.सं.एनसीटीई-रेगु011/80/2018-एमएस(विनियमन)-मुख्यालय-राष्ट्रीय अध्यापक शिक्षा परिषद अधिनियम, 1993 (1993 का 73वां) की धारा 32 की उप-खंड (1) और (2) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, राष्ट्रीय अध्यापक शिक्षा परिषद एतद्वारा राष्ट्रीय अध्यापक शिक्षा परिषद (मान्यता, मानदंड तथा क्रियाविधि) विनियम, 2014 में निम्नलिखित संशोधन करती है, अर्थात्: -

Norms and Standards for Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

- The ITEP shall be offered after Senior Secondary (+2) or its equivalent examination
- The ITEP programme emphasizes on preparing teachers as envisaged in Pedagogical and Curricular restructuring of school education under NEP 2020.
- The ITEP aims at the dual purpose of providing student teachers disciplinary knowledge along with the professional knowledge in an integrated manner.

Norms and Standards for Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP)

- This programme will prepare teachers for the new curricular and pedagogical structure of school education like Fundamental, Preparatory, Middle and Secondary
- ITEP shall be implemented in a phase wise manner starting from piloting in multidisciplinary HEIS/TEIs and thereby country wide expansion as per NEP 2020 timeframe.
- The exit system shall be applicable in ITEP as finalized in the National Higher Education Qualification Framework by UGC aligned with NEP 2020.

Intake, Eligibility, Admission Procedure

- **Intake:** The basic unit shall comprise of fifty students each in the programme.
- **Eligibility:** Candidates with minimum fifty percent marks in Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent (under 5+3+3+4 pattern) from a recognised board are eligible for admission.
- **Admission Procedure:**
 - a) Admission in ITEP shall be through a suitable subject and aptitude test conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA)
 - A single nation-wide entrance test called National Common Entrance Test (NCET)
 - At the time of admission to the programme, the candidate must indicate the subjects/discipline (B.A. B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Com. B.Ed.).

Curriculum and Programme Implementation:

- The Curriculum and the implementation of the programme shall be based on the Model/Suggestive Curriculum developed by NCTE. However, different universities and institutions conducting this programme will be allowed up to 30% flexibility while adapting or modifying the Model/Suggestive Curriculum as per local requirements.
- Assessment and Evaluation: The evaluation pattern as per the Suggestive Curriculum Framework developed by NCTE would be followed.

Rationale of Submitting Application for earlier mentioned 3 Unites of ITEP

- Present invitation of applications for ITEP by NCTE is for Central Government/ State Government Institutions to start it on Pilot Basis.
- Being fully centrally funded Deemed University DEI is applying in Category of Central Govt. Institutions.
- NCTE Portal is accepting applications for maximum three courses.

- DEI is Applying for 3 units out of which 1 units of B. A. B.Ed. of foundation Level ITEP as this course will prepare teachers for Foundation level classes (First Level of 5+3+3+4 Structure of Education proposed by NEP, 2020) as presently we do not run any B.Ed. Course for this level). We are also applying for 1 units of B. Sc. B.Ed. Of Middle Level (Class 6th to 8th) and 1 units of B. Com. B.Ed. of Secondary Level (Class 9th to 12th)
- In order to cover all levels of teacher education and to widen the spectrum of teacher education courses Institute is applying for the courses of three levels of different streams.
