# OPERATING GUIDELINES FOR AWARD OF DEI FOUNDER'S MEDAL (2023-24)

Object: "DEI Founder's Medal" is instituted with the purpose of encouraging students to develop all-round excellence and thus is awarded to the best all-rounder student who is adjudged as the best among the students of first degree level Academic Programmes of the Institute.

## Stage 1: Initial Screening

- Top fifteen percent (15%) or top ten (10) positions, whichever is lower, among the passed-out students, belonging to first degree level (3-year degree for Honours Classes, 4-year degree for B.F.A. & B.Tech., and 5-year degree of B.Arch.) in the various academic programmes of the Faculties of Arts, Commerce, Engineering, Science and Social Sciences, in terms of academic performance of all the semesters of the degree programme, would be invited by the respective Deans and DEP Centre Incharges, to apply for the Founder's Medal of the Institute.
- The aforesaid students should have a minimum CGPA of 7.5 out of 10.
- The student should have demonstrated good conduct during the stay at the Institute or at the DEP Centres of the Institute. In case of any disciplinary proceedings against the student, he/ she would be allowed to proceed beyond initial screening stage only when his/ her candidature is cleared for it by the Institute Disciplinary Committee.

## Stage 2: Break-up of Scoring for award of the Founder's Medal

The candidates would be awarded score as per their performance in the following categories after Stage 1 (Initial Screening). For the purpose, they would use the pro forma given on the following pages (2 to 4) for entering detailed break-up of their achievement in the various activities undertaken by them during their stay at the Institute, for the academic programme under consideration:

Categories	Maximum Marks (100)
1. Inter Disciplinary and Academics	30 marks
2. Physical Activities	25 marks
3. Literary Activities	15 marks
4. Cultural Activities	15 marks
5. Leadership & Service Activities	15 marks

#### Stage 3:

After Stage 2, the following additional criterion may be used for short-listing for final selection:

The candidate should secure at least 50 marks out of 100 marks in the aggregate at Stage 2, with a minimum of 40% marks, separately, in at least 3 out of the 5 Categories listed above under Stage 2.

#### **Final Selection for Award of Founder's Medal:**

The candidate scoring the highest aggregate marks after Stage 2 and Stage 3 would be selected for the award of the **Founder's Medal** of the Institute.
