





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Special Issue Commemorating Centenary of Dayalbagh and Education in Dayalbagh



International School on Quantum and Nano Computing Systems (QANSAS 2014) was organized from November 26–30, 2014 with 24 invited speakers from top academic and research institutes including University of Waterloo, University of California at Berkeley; University of California at Los Angeles; Mt. San Antonio College, California; IIT Delhi, IIT Kanpur, JNU Delhi, IMSc Chennai, ISI Kolkata, IISER Kolkata, IIT BHU, TIFR Mumbai, and of course, DEI, Dayalbagh.

Kesavan, Founder Chairman, Department of Systems Design Engineering, University of Waterloo, one of the founding fathers of the close ties between DEI and University of Waterloo over five decades. A few years earlier, there was much greater resistance to accepting any religious or spiritual philosophy. However, over the past few years, past three years to be more precise, it has begun to get better. There are scientists of tall standing who have begun to see merit in relating quantum science with eastern philosophy and Radhasoami spiritual phenomenology as representing a consistent and complete perspective, for emerging global philosophy of consciousness.
