





In the above context, reference is drawn to the gazette notification SO 2719 dated 28th Nov 2000 subjecting Milk Products to quality control and inspection prior to export. Clause no 15 of the said notification is reproduced as under:

'Nothing in this order shall apply to the export by land or sea or air of bonafide samples of milk products to prospective buyer, the value of which shall not exceed permissible limits as laid down in exim policy from time to time and where no such provisions exist. the value limit of free samples shall not exceed Rs 10.000\(^2\).

Copy of the notification is also enclosed for ready reference in order to enable you to take necessary action in the matter.
