Only Medal / Ph.D. Degree recipients shall be permitted inside the convocation Hall.

Apart from the above the following Dress Code mandatorily be required for entry into the main campus:-

- (b) Female candidates will wear a white blouse and white saree
- (c) The formal academic capes of different colours assigned separately for each faculty is to wear mandatorily available on the Institute counter and must be returned immediately after the convocation. In the event of not returning the capes, Rs. 300/- shall be deducted from the caution money of the student.
- (d) Students would be permitted only if they are in uniform as per the dress code and are wearing masks and helmets. Social Distancing will have to be maintained at all times.
