The significance of the topic and overall evaluation

This manuscript has an interesting and appropriate topic for the Journal of Leisure Research. Although many minorities go through conflicts and challenges in their daily living including leisure engagement globally, the majority of the research has been focusing on those who are residing in the U.S. Hence, it was meaningful attempt to explore the leisure constraints of the minorities outside of the US. Moreover, this manuscript could have both meaningful practical implications and theoretical implications to the field. Despite the strengths of the study, the manuscript still needs some improvements to be considered as a publishable in Journal of Leisure Research. Therefore, I would recommend the article to be 'major revision'

Detailed feedback and requested changes are explained in the synthesis of the reviews below. Content of Research

Overall the introduction and literature review were well written. The authors provided appropriate statistics and sufficient references to support their arguments. Moreover, the introduction, theoretical framework, and literature review were cohesive and reader-friendly.

However, the rationale of selecting 'perceived-constraint-reduction' model was confusing. I have looked over some of the references that the authors cited to support his model selection. However, some of the references were rather supporting the 'constraint-effect-mitigating model' than 'perceived-constraint-perceived-constraint-perceived-constraint-reduction' model.

Minor changes

It would be nice to mention the "literature review" section on Page 7.

- In the methods section, several questions and clarifications are needed. Please include an example of each scale, so the readers could have an idea of the scale.
- Provide reliabilities of each scale in the measurement section as well (maybe just the score of
- Did you only measure the monthly income of the participants? Since the majority of the participants are married, it would be more reasonable to measure the average income of the family than measuring only Cronbach's alpha)
- Why did you use the path analysis rather than SEM? Path analysis is for the observable variables. But, your factors are latent variables. Thus, I would recommend using SEM, not the path analysis. the participant.
- To determine whether 'leisure constraints' is a mediator between 'constrain negotiation' and 'leisure participation intention', you need to measure the indirect effect of constraint negotiation on 'constrain negotiation' through 'leisure constraints'. However, this seems not measured in this study. In this case, I believe you cannot determine whether 'leisure constraints' is a mediator or not.





ABSTRACT:

The present study endeavors to comprehend the motives and challenges of women entrepreneurs managing the home-based businesses (HBB) in Pakistan.

This qualitative study is based on in-depth interviewees with 20 HBB women entrepreneurs in Pakistan. Purposeful sampling was used to choose the interviewees to ensure a diverse sample of interviewees in terms of age, experience, and type of business.

The motivations for establishing HBBs appear to be multifaceted, involving individual and work-related incidents identified within the practices of women entrepreneurs. Some of the challenges acknowledged as impediments to HBB women entrepreneurs include difficulties in acquiring start-up capital, lack of training, networking opportunities, and gender discrimination.

For the present study, gender refers to the masculine discernment. By excluding men (specifically, fathers, husbands, and sons), we have to some extent restricted our research. However, we argue that, in relative footings, facilitating women's voice is not a limitation but rather a substantial contribution, given women's

traditional invisibility in a conservative society like Pakistan.

The present study contributes to existing, but limited, knowledge about HBB women entrepreneurs in Pakistan, a developing Islamic country, which can offer better understanding of a previously little-explored context. Given the lack of understanding of HBBs, particularly in connection to women entrepreneurs, the present study can be useful for the researchers in the field of women's entrepreneurship.



ABSTRACT: The purpose of this paper is to investigate the impact of customer attitude and judgement regarding three types of banking system operating in Pakistan. These types of financial institutions consist of conventional, Islamic and conventional standalone bank branches.

This study has collected the primary data through adopted questionnaires and used statistical package of social sciences (SPSS) software for data analysis. However, three hundred sixty (360) questionnaires distributed among equal ratio of customers of three types of banking system and response rate is 96 percentage from mark customers. The results indicate that fifty four (54) percentage of conventional customers are ready to shift their accounts into Islamic banks. 
